A Rotta Love Plus To Help Seized Sibley County Dogs

Minneapolis (Sept. 8, 2006) – After the seizure of 44 dogs from a Sibley County home yesterday, **A Rotta Love Plus**, a Rottweiler and Pit Bull Rescue, Rehoming and Education organization, pledged to do what it can to help to the local Humane Societies care for the remaining dogs.

More than half of the mastiff, terrier, pit bull, and pit bull-mix breeds seized from the home were euthanized due to health and behavioral issues, according to the local humane societies.

“We understand the love of these breeds,” said Tiffany Huebner, director and founder of A Rotta Love Plus. “But sometimes we can’t help every single animal. That’s why we only allow our network of foster families to care for a maximum of three dogs at one time. We ensure that every dog receives a complete behavior and medical evaluation and health care, every potential owner receives a complete screening, and every ‘forever home’ fits both their needs.”

Celebrating its tenth year, and voted second-best rescue organization in the Twin Cities by TC Dog’s 2005 Reader’s Choice Poll, **A Rotta Love Plus** has been steadily growing its volunteer base and program offerings.

“Not only does our organization rescue and rehome rottweilers, pit bull terriers and other mixed breeds, but we help educate the public about responsible dog ownership and bite prevention,” said Huebner.
